A meeting of Butcombe Parish Council will be held in the Village Hall on Friday 7th February, starting at 6.30pm. The purpose of the meeting is to make a final decision on a proposal to set aside £3,000 per annum to pay for minor works such as clearing roadside ditches, as North Somerset Council are no longer able to provide this service. This would mean that we would need to increase the parish precept by at least 50% from 2026/7.
